THANK YOU for supporting our club's FIRST Agility 'A' Match! Your support allows our club to learn about the trial-giving process. Without your entries our club cannot gain the skills for holding a full-fledged trial. The AKC requires clubs to hold 'A' matches to establish the club's eligibility to hold Licensed Agility Trials. These matches are more formal than fun matches or 'B/OB' Matches and must closely resemble a true licensed trial. Therefore, no food, toys or additional run-thrus can be allowed. Your participation in an 'A' Match allows our club to complete it's requirements to move forward trial giving status, and allows agility to continue to grow in our area.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-thru allows the handlers to plan a strategy for running the course. A walk-thru period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitor use. Exhibitors may not use the warm up area to relieve their dogs.

CONFIRMATIONS

If you provide a LEGIBLE email address, final confirmation of your entry and a schedule of judging will be sent to the email address provided—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received a copy of your confirmation five days before the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for first–fourth place in each jump height for each class. Qualifying ribbons (green with pink edges) will be awarded to all dogs which receive a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify in order to earn a placement ribbon. Qualifying scores will receive a \$5 voucher off future SSC agility events. All prizes must be claimed on the day of the trial. Every dog **ENTERED** will receive a toy valued between \$1:00 to \$1:50 or a treat valued at \$1.00. **No title legs will be awarded. Qualifying Scores do not count toward AKC agility titles.**

HOW TO ENTER THE MATCH

Checks should be made out to SSCG . **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE** your check to the entry form. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be returned. If you include a **legible** email address, we will notify you of the acceptance status of your entry. Dogs may not switch between Regular and Preferred classes within the match.

Move-up requests must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, March 15, 2010 at 6 p.m. They may be emailed to pegfranklin@morrisbb.net . Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested.

DIRECTIONS TO MATCH SITE

From North or South on GA 400 –

Exit GA 400 at Exit 10, Old Milton Pkwy (GA 120) and turn to go West. If coming from South, turn left. Turn right if coming from North. Continue past GA HWY 9 (Main St) to Wills Rd (next light after swimming pool on left). Turn left and Equestrian Center will be on your left. We will be under the large covered arena.

From West –From Hwy 92, turn left onto Hardscrabble Rd (at new Target, et al). Continue until it ends at Crabapple Rd and turn left. Turn right immediately onto Rucker Rd and continue to Wills Rd. Turn right on Wills Rd. Equestrian Center will be on your left.

From East –

From Pleasant Hill Rd, continue across Hwy 141 as it becomes States Bridge Rd. and then Old Milton Pkwy. Continue past GA HWY 9 and follow the above directions.

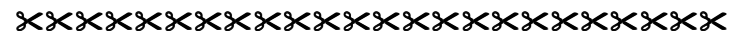
From Holcomb Bridge Rd proceed to GA 400 and go North on GA 400. Follow directions as above.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 6 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.
- The match-giving club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
 - Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Match Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks. Refunds of less than \$5 will not be made.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials".
- **Bitches in season and ill or injured dogs are not eligible to compete.** No refunds shall be made for requests for refunds made after the closing date/time.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

MEASURING

In accordance with AKC regulations, all dogs, with the exception of 24" and 26" class dogs, must either present a temporary or permanent height card, or be measured by the judge of record prior to running. If a Voluntary Measuring Official or Rep is present at the match, ALL dogs without a valid height card must be measured. If your dog does not have a jump height card, they will need to be measured prior to running. You should carry your jump height card with you and be able to present the card if requested at the trial. **It is the handler's responsibility to make sure their dog without a height card is measured prior to the commencement of their first class. Judging will not be held or interrupted for measuring.**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers of dogs in Regular Classes may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes **MUST** jump in their measured division and are not allowed to jump higher or lower.

Ring 1: Excellent Standard, Open Standard, Novice Standard

Ring 2: Excellent JWW, Open JWW, Novice JWW

Jump height will be high to low. Preferred classes will run with Regular classes.

Measuring: As announced. **It is the handler's responsibility to make sure their dog without a height card is measured prior to the commencement of their first class. Judging will not be held or interrupted for measuring.**

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
