**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

If you do not have an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, but would like to earn ASCA titles, please register your dog with ASCA using the form included with this premium. ASCA awards agility titles to all breeds and mixes.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler not in good standing with ASCA..

**FCASC requires that you pick up after your dog at the show site and the hotel. No grooming or bathing of dogs in the hotel room! Do not leave dogs unattended in rooms. Any complaints made by the hotel could result in loss of future trial privileges.** All dogs must be on lead. No parking in fire lanes. Bitches in heat are not allowed to compete. Refunds will be provided for bitches in heat as long as owner notifies trial secretary prior to the trial. At each trial, **7 HIT awards** are given out each day for Novice, Open, Elite, Veteran, All-American, Aussie and Junior. HIT is calculated using the two regular rounds each day. 9 points for a 10 point elite Q run, 4.5 for a faulted elite Q run. 7 points for a 10 point open Q run, 3.5 for a faulted open Q run. 5 points for a 10 point

novice Q run, 2.5 for a faulted novice Q run. In the event of ties, fastest combined time from qualifying runs wins. 1<sup>st</sup> —4<sup>th</sup> placement ribbons and qualifying ribbons are awarded for each class as well. Prizes are given out for 1<sup>st</sup> places.

**NOTE: We will be doing worker raft for this trial. Sign up to work and win money and credit towards future entries!**

**Directions:** From GA400, take the Old Milton Pkwy exit. Go West off the exit. Go 2 miles and turn left on Wills Rd. Go 1/4 mile and turn left into Wills Park Equestrian Center. The trial is in the front soccer arena.

**Hotels:** La Quinta Inn —1350 North Point Dr. Alpharetta, GA 30004. 770-754-7800

**Camping** —RV spaces \$20 a night, electrical and water hookups. Dump station available on site. Please include RV payment with entries.

**Measuring** and walk throughs will be at 4:30 Friday with the first run at 5pm. On Saturday and Sunday it will be at 7:30am and the first run will be at 8:00 am. *All classes will begin with the Elite level and will run small to tall.* The order of classes will be as follows:

**Friday:** Jumpers 1 & 2. Warm up

**Saturday:** Gamblers 1 (EON), Gamblers 2 (EON), Jumpers (EON), 2 Regular (EON)

**Sunday:** Gamblers (EON), 2 Jumpers, (EEOONN), 2 Regular (EON)

This order is subject to change after entries close.

**Please double check your confirmation letter!!**

**No changes will be made Saturday morning!**

Dogs are not allowed to wear collars in ASCA Agility. Training in the ring is permitted, however, the dog will receive an elimination. For more information on ASCA rules, please visit [www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org).

### **Titling Class Descriptions:**

**Regular** —The regular class contains all the agility obstacles. There is a specified course that the dog

must follow. Faults can be incurred for things such as knocked bars, missed contacts and wrong courses. A clean run earns a dog a 10 point Q. A run with 5 or less faults will earn a dog a 5 point Q. 30 points are required to title at each level.

**Jumpers** —The Jumpers class contains jumps and tunnels. There is a specified course that the dog must follow. Faults can be incurred for things such as wrong courses or knocked bars. A clean run earns a dog a qualifying score. Two qualifying scores are required to title at each level.

**Gamblers** —A two part game where the handler guides the dog through a course of his choosing in an attempt to earn points during the opening period. At the end of the opening period, the handler directs the dog to the 'gamble area'. The handler will direct the dog to perform the gamble without crossing the 'gamble line'. A dog must earn the minimum number of opening points in addition to performing the gamble successfully in order to earn a qualifying score. Two qualifying scores are required to title at each level.

### AGREEMENT

- As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs, and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the grounds, lighting, security measures or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals, and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising for these.
- Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA (including all officers, directors employees, and members), FCASC, including all officers, directors, members and organizing committee/s, and Wills Park Equestrian (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

## ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

**Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs** – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of 'Service' is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.** Please type or print clearly. Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned.
